- 12 The specific business in which the corporation is 13 rimarily to engage is to receive and hold titlecto certain real frequenty constituting the common areas of a condominium development 15 Located in the City of Palm Springs, County of Riverside, State of 16 California, and commonly known as the "Riviera Gardens", and to 17 maintain such property for the common benefit of the condominium 18 owners.
- פב (b) To engage in all lawful activities and operations 20 usually and normally engaged in by a home owners' association.
- _21 (c) To initiate, amend, repeal and modify by-laws .22 governing the improvements to the condominium structures, the con-23 duct of the home owners owning such condominium atructures, and -24 establishing other lawful rules and regulations for the common 25 good and benefit of the home owners of the condominium project.
- (d) To possess and exercise all of the powers conferred 27 by law upon nonprofit corporations and have all other powers and domall other acts necessary or incidental to the administration of the affairs and for carrying out the purposes of this corporation, including, without limitation, any or all of the following acts or things:
 - To buy, lease, rent, or otherwise acquire, hold (1)

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or use, own, sell, exchange, lease as leasor, pledge, encumber and dispose of any and all kinds of property, whother real, personal or mixed.

- (2) To borrow money and to contract debts; to issue bonds, notes, and other evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the same by any or all of the property of this corporation, or to issue the same unsecured.
- To enter into, make, perform and carry out partnerships, joint ventures, and contracts, of every kind, for any lawful purpose, and without limit as to amount with any person, firm or corporation.

III

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California. Nothing contained in the foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed to authorize this corporation to carry on any activity for the profit 17#of its members, or to distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to any of its members as such, except upon dissolution or winding up.

The county in the State of California where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located is Riverside County.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be not less than three (3) nor more than five (5). The exact number of directors shall be fixed from time to time within the limits specified by this Article V or controlling By-Laws, by a by-law or amendment thereof duly adopted by the shareholders or by the Board of Directors.
